RESPONSIBLE RESEARCH AND INNOVATION IN H2020: CURRENT STATUS AND STEPS FORWARD

The NewHoRRizon project published its first policy brief in May 2018.

The policy brief aims at offering evidence based policy recommendations – informed by the first inputs of NewHoRRizon research efforts across 19 Social Labs – to policy makers, journalists and interested researchers and innovators on the state of play of Responsible Research and Innovation (RRI) in Horizon 2020 (H2020) and proposing immediate actions to consider for mainstreaming RRI in the next framework program, FP9 Horizon Europe (HE).

Our recommendations include:

- focus on excellence
- capacity building and training of program officers, evaluators, researchers, innovators and other stakeholders
- further investments in methods of monitoring and evaluating RRI implementation
